COMMUNICABLE DISEASE PREVENTION PLAN

A communicable disease is an illness caused by an infectious agent that can be transmitted from one person to another.

The Halina Centre Communicable Disease Prevention Plan has been implemented to help reduce the spread of diseases. The following are restrictions that are taking effect at the Centre to keep everyone safe.

1. Do not attend the Centre if you are not feeling well. You are putting yourself and others at risk
2. Utilize the provided hand hygiene products and/or utilize one of the 6 washrooms within the Centre.
3. Maintain a clean space and equipment by utilizing the provided sanitization products after use.
4. Respect others' space. Maintain a 6' social distancing circle when able
5. Masks are recommended. This is to protect yourself and others.

The Halina Centre has reviewed the Provincial Health Orders as well as the Public Health rulings and modifications have been implemented within the Centre.
